PURPOSE OF THE SUMMIT

The 2-day Traditional Leaders Summit is dedicated to the Eastern Seaboard Region Traditional Leadership, a critical stakeholder and partner, with the objective of crystalising their participation and role in the implementation phase of the Eastern Seaboard Development Programme.

OBJECTIVES AND EXCPECTED OUTCOMES OF THE SUMMIT
